

Each year, Virginia Tech hosts thousands of special events on campus that require a change in parking and traffic regulations. Some of the regularly scheduled events that have the most significant impact include athletics events, including football and basketball games, commencement each December and May, and events at the Moss Arts Center. Reminders are shared in Virginia Tech News and by email in advance of major events.

FOOTBALL PARKING

To accommodate the increased volume of vehicular traffic on campus, the following parking and traffic changes are in place for home football games. Vehicles not removed may be ticketed and towed. This year, Virginia Tech will host one weekday game, **Thursday**, **September 22**. Please pay special attention to all signs and emails concerning this weeknight game.

ONE DAY BEFORE THE GAME

No parking after 5 p.m. All vehicles must be removed by 7 p.m.:



Commuter, graduate, and resident student vehicles parked along the outside perimeter of the Duck Pond Drive Lot (the Cage) must be moved by **5 p.m.**

No parking after **5 p.m.** All vehicles must be removed from the Coliseum Lot (corner of Washington Street and Beamer Way) by **7 p.m.** All resident student vehicles must be removed from the Stadium and Chicken Hill lots by **7 p.m.**

Resident students may park in the following area:

- > Resident section of Duck Pond Drive Lot (the Cage) interior spaces only.
- > Resident student vehicles must be back in resident lots by **7 a.m.** the next day.



COMMENCEMENT PARKING

The Coliseum Lot is reserved until 12 p.m. for students moving out. After that, and until the end of the commencement ceremonies on Saturday, the lot is reserved for handicapped and special needs guests and the commencement stage party.

FRIDAY AND SATURDAY

The Coliseum Lot is reserved for handicapped and special needs guests and the commencement stage party. The Track/Soccer Lot is reserved for the procession. The Stadium Lot has spaces reserved for handicap and special needs guests.

BASKETBALL PARKING

Please pay special attention to all signs and emails concerning mens and women's basketball games. Dates and times may vary. Vehicles not removed may be ticketed.

- Coliseum Lot (corner of Washington Street and Beamer Way)
- > Track/Field House Lot (on Beamer Way)
- > Stadium Lot West

Additionally, the Litton-Reaves Lot is restricted the day before the game to no new parking after 5:30 p.m. All vehicles already parked in the lot may remain.

Public parking for home basketball games is available in the Duck Pond Drive Lot (the Cage). Vehicles should be parked in the large section closest to the Duck Pond.

Accessible parking is available in Coliseum Lot.

MOSS ARTS CENTER PARKING

Parking is available for a fee in the North End Center Garage on Turner Street during events.

Other nearby parking options on campus include the Architecture Annex, Lower Stanger, Squires, and Substation lots and on-street parking on Alumni Mall and other campus streets. Parking on campus is free after 10 p.m. and on weekends, unless signed otherwise.

Off-campus parking options include lots on Church Street and Progress Street. Limited on-street parking is available as well.

There is limited accessible parking located just outside the building on both Turner Street and Alumni Mall. Additional accessible parking is available in the North End Center Garage and other campus lots. Patrons can drop-off and pick-up guests at the entrance.
